

Procedure for Reporting Lost or Stolen iPads 2016/17

The procedure might be slightly different based on a variety of circumstances.

1. First, be sure to look everyone! I know this might sound obvious, but most of our “lost” iPads are located in backpacks, at homes or in cars. Even our police officer has commented that the reported stolen ones are actually with the student.
2. Please notify the Verona Area High School Technology Department. We can put the device in Lost Mode & map its last location.

3. Parent/guardian should contact the police and file a police report. We recommend doing this if you know for sure it is stolen. Again, in many instances it is misplaced. Doing this as soon as possible is recommended. You will have a much better chance of tracking down and recovering the iPad if it is reported within a timely manner.
